

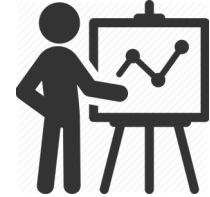
Business Management & Finance Cluster



Business Management Program

PROGRAM OF STUDY OVERVIEW:

Students begin the Business Management Program with two foundation courses, which are taken at the home schools: Principles of Business Management and Entrepreneurship and Principles of Accounting and Finance. Students who complete the Business Management pathway will be able to develop a business plan for a small business.

Students who complete this program pathway will be able to develop a business plan for a small business. They will apply accounting, marketing, and management concepts to realistic business scenarios. All aspects of managing a business will be discussed in addition to the competencies learned in computer applications, business communications and financial management. The Business Management Program of study recommends that students take advantage of work study, mentorship, internship, and job shadow opportunities. Students will also benefit from involvement in the Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) organization. This program of study does have a credit by examination through the College Board CLEP exam. Students who completes this program will be prepared to work as a management trainee, manage a small business, and continue their education after graduation.
