

DISTANCE LEARNING SCHOOL DAY

PARENT GUIDELINES: GRADES 9 – 12

In the event that distance learning is required (i.e. calendar changes, inclement weather), the distance learning pathway offers students the ability to actively participate in their own learning through the use of various resources.

WHAT TO EXPECT

High school students in grades 9–12 will access assignments via Schoology, our learning management system. All assignments will be posted to Schoology by 10:00am on distance learning days.

ATTENDANCE

Students' attendance will be verified by their login within Schoology.

DUE DATES

Assigned work must be submitted within five (5) school days following the return to in-person learning. Teachers will direct students how work will be submitted.

GRADING

Assigned work will be graded at the teacher's discretion and can be counted as participation.
