1. A completed scholarship application
2. Proof of enrollment from the Francis King Carey School of Law at the University of Maryland
3. Three letters of recommendation from non-family members
4. Official transcript of grades
5. A one-page essay on "Why I am pursuing a career in Law"
6. Applicants may be required to be interviewed by the Scholarship Advisory Committee.

Other Considerations

Preference may be given to applicants with the greatest financial need.
